b) I declare and undertake that if authorised, I shall work as a RFPE in Singapore and:

- i) be bound by the Professional Engineers Act and the Professional Engineers (Code Of Professional Conduct And Ethics) Rules;
- ii) be bound by laws and regulations of Singapore;
- iii) work in collaboration with a designated professional engineer (PE) registered with PEB and who have a valid practicing certificate, not in independent practice and not making submissions to any statutory authorities of Singapore, and be subject to the laws and regulations of Singapore governing the practice of engineering; and
- iv) abide by any terms and conditions as may be prescribed by PEB.

c) I declare that if authorised I shall work in collaboration with the following designated PE registered with PEB subject to the said PE holding a valid Practising Certificate. (The declaration of the designated PE is attached)

d) I understand that if authorised, my name will be placed on the Register of Registered Foreign Professional Engineers and is deemed to continue to be on the list only if the following conditions are met:

- i) I continue to hold a valid Practising Certificate or equivalent in my home country.
- ii) I continue to collaborate with the abovementioned designated PE registered with PEB.
- iii) The abovementioned designated PE registered with PEB continues to hold a valid Practising Certificate.
- iv) Compliance with all prescribed terms and conditions.

e) I declare that if authorised,

- i) I shall, where applicable, apply and obtain a registration for business as a sole-proprietor with the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA) and apply and obtain a permit to engage in work (such as an Employment Pass) issued by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) before commencement of collaboration with the designated PE;
- ii) I shall not collaborate as an employee of a registered professional engineer or a partnership consisting wholly of registered professional engineers; or a director, partner, or employee of a licensed professional engineering practice;
- iii) I shall engage in PE work only on the basis of collaboration with the designated PE.

f) I declare and certify that I have never been charged with and found guilty of violation of technical, professional or ethical standards in the practice of engineering, either here locally or in any other country,

g) I hereby authorise PEB to seek verification on the information submitted in any manner and by any means as it deems fit and proper.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS OF AUTHORISATION AS REGISTERED FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS (RFPE) IN PRESCRIBED BRANCHES OF ENGINEERING

- 1 An ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE) in the prescribed branches of chemical, civil, electrical or mechanical engineering from ASEAN member countries may apply to Professional Engineers Board (PEB) for authorisation to work as a Registered Foreign Professional Engineer (RFPE) in Singapore.
- 2 An ACPE applying for authorisation as Registered Foreign Professional Engineer (RFPE) is required to hold a valid Practising Certificate or equivalent from the home country.
- 3 An ACPE applying for authorisation as Registered Foreign Professional Engineer (RFPE) is required to submit a declaration by a professional engineer (PE) registered with PEB with a valid Practising Certificate who shall be the designated PE with whom he intends to work in collaboration.
- 4 An ACPE shall apply for RFPE authorisation with not more than one designated PE at any time.
- 5 An ACPE applying for RFPE authorisation shall not be an employee of a registered professional engineer or a partnership consisting wholly of registered professional engineers; or as a director, partner, or employee of a licensed professional engineering practice.
- 6 Application for authorisation must be submitted on the prescribed forms issued by the PEB with the prescribed fees. The application must be legibly written in ink or type-written and submitted with a recent passport size photograph.
- 7 Application for authorisation must be accompanied by photostat copies of the necessary documents. If requested, you are required to bring along the original copies of these documents for the Board's verification.
- 8 A successful applicant shall be authorised by PEB to work as a RFPE in Singapore, not in independent practice, but in collaboration with a designated local PE with a valid PC in accordance with the provisions of the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement On Engineering Services and with the Professional Engineers Act and Regulations as well as other prescribed conditions of registration. (For full details see section 4.1 of the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Engineering Services at <http://www.aseansec.org/18010.htm> and sections 10(1) and 10(1A) of the Professional Engineers Act at <http://app.peb.gov.sg>)
- 9 Where applicable, a successful applicant shall apply and obtain a registration for business as a sole-proprietor with the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA) and apply and obtain a permit to engage in work (such as an Employment Pass) issued by the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) before commencement of collaboration with the designated PE.
- 10 A successful applicant shall be authorised as RFPE for a validity period of one year and renewable on a yearly basis subject to meeting the prescribed conditions.
- 11 A RFPE shall not collaborate as an employee of the designated PE.
- 12 An RFPE shall not collaborate as an employee of a registered professional engineer or a partnership consisting wholly of registered professional engineers; or as a director, partner, or employee of a licensed professional engineering practice.
- 13 A RFPE shall engage in PE work only on the basis of collaboration with the designated PE.
- 14 A RFPE and the designated Singapore PE are advised to work out terms of agreement specific to their collaboration which could include insurance and other liability considerations.
